

# Liberton Kirk Daily Devotions – November 2025

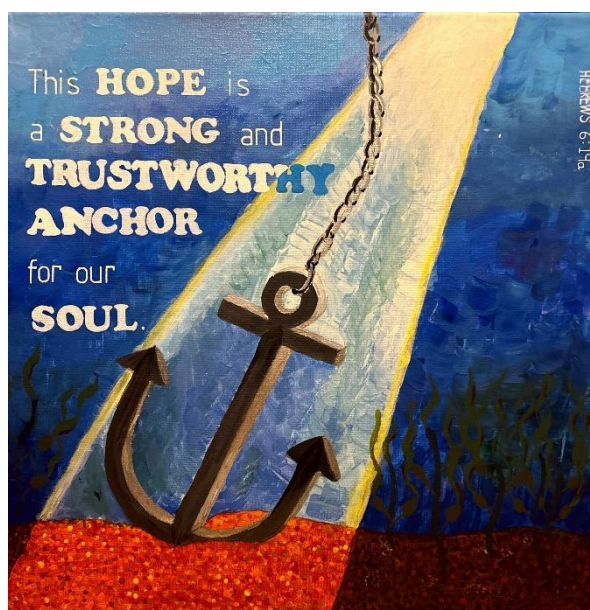
*Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us.*

*Hebrews 12 verse 1*

During 2025 we have been looking daily at the theme of 'ITS ALL ABOUT JESUS'. So far, we have considered some of the things He did and said and how the Early Church followed His teachings.

We pause at our times of Midday Devotion to pray for others in our church family, our city and our world.

In November we continue the journey with some of his followers through their New Testament letters as we consider the truths behind the words.



We are all invited to listen for God's voice and make our response as we journey together daily in our 'rhythm of devotion' in 2025.

These Devotions are but one way to feed on God's Word in the morning, at midday, in the evening... to pray with Him continually through the day and even to share with others the treasures or hurdles you discover.

The Church website and Facebook page (even on a handy mobile) provide a fuller daily devotional page. However, it all follows the pattern below which the information provided fits into, based on the Kirk's origins of the Celtic and Northumbrian traditions which we started as a church family back in 2015.

**Morning:**

Reading and Meditation on the content, and Prayer of response

**Midday:**

Prayer – mostly for others

**Evening:**

Verse(s) from the morning reading

Reflection and Prayer at the end of the day

**Prayer of the Month:**

*Jesus Christ, the Supreme King,  
Guide us this day, week and month,  
To follow your teachings,  
To show Your love and our faith through our deeds.  
Help us to hold strong in times of suffering,  
Recognizing those who would lead us astray.  
We worship You, our LORD,  
Amen.*

Saturday 1st November

**Morning:**

Reading: HEBREWS 1:1-4.

Meditation: as we pause with Jesus we take time to consider these words and truths afresh.

- Heir of all things
- Right hand of the Majesty

And then pray to this God.

*Lord of radiant light,  
Shine in our lives this new month,  
Let Your majesty of your heavenly throne,  
be seen through us.  
In Your name, amen.*

**Midday:**

Pray the words of the Lord's Prayer as your own prayer today.

*Our Father, who art in heaven,  
Hallowed be thy name.  
Thy Kingdom come.  
Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.*

*Give us this day our daily bread.  
And forgive us our debts,  
as we forgive our debtors.  
And lead us not into temptation,  
but deliver us from evil.  
For thine is the Kingdom,  
the power and the glory, forever.  
Amen.*

### **Evening:**

Read the verses again from HEBREWS 1:1-4.  
Reflect and pray in response to what you read.

*Father, speak to us this evening,  
let us know the path You want us to take.  
We are listening in this time of reflection,  
for Your Son to speak to us.  
In Jesus' name, amen.*

Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> November

### **Morning:**

Reading: HEBREWS 2:5-18.

Meditation: we take time to consider these words this morning.

- Crowned with glory and honour

And then we pray to this God in response.

*Lord Jesus, we cannot thank You enough for what You have done for us.  
You took the sin of the world to the cross,  
giving us salvation and calling us brothers and sisters.  
In Your name, amen.*

### **Midday:**

Pray the words of the Prayer for the Month as your own prayer.

*Jesus Christ, the Supreme King,  
Guide us this day, week and month,  
To follow your teachings,  
To show Your love and our faith through our deeds.  
Help us to hold strong in times of suffering,  
Recognizing those who would lead us astray.*

*We worship You, our LORD,  
Amen.*

**Evening:**

Read these set words again from HEBREWS 2:5-18.  
Reflect and then pray to this God of ours.

*Lord, at the end this day, we turn in praise to You again.  
You came to Earth, became human,  
endured suffering and temptation,  
but overcoming both.  
Give us the same strength in our times of hardship,  
walking beside us, as family.  
In Your name, amen.*

Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November

**Morning:**

Reading: HEBREWS 3:1-6.

Meditation: as we pause with God, take time to consider these particular words today.

- We are his house

And then pray in response.

*Lord, we are Your house.  
Live in us.  
Shine through us.  
Let Your deeds be our deeds.  
We give our life to You,  
build Your church through us.  
In Jesus' name, amen.*

**Midday:**

We pray God's blessing on the work of OPEN DOORS in our world.

*Lord, remove the persecution of Your people in this world, amen.*

**Evening:**

Read the verses again from HEBREWS 3:1-6.  
Reflect and then pray to this God in response.

*We fix our thoughts on You, O Lord.  
We acknowledge your sovereignty.  
We build our house on You, and in You.  
In Your name, amen.*

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> November

**Morning:**

Reading: HEBREWS 4:4-16.

Meditation: as we pause with God today we consider these truths.

- Enter that rest
- Approach God with confidence

And then respond in prayer with Him.

*Father, in the busyness of life,  
we can easily forget to rest.  
Show us Lord, how to rest in You.  
And in that rest, to listen for and to You.  
In Jesus' name, amen.*

**Midday:**

Take time to listen for God to speak with you – ask, seek, knock – hear!

*We are here Lord, knocking, seeking, asking and listening. Amen.*

**Evening:**

Read the words again from HEBREWS 4:4-16.

Reflect and then pray in response to our God.

*Lord, we approach Your throne in confidence,  
thanking You for the grace and mercy  
You freely grant to us.  
In Your name, amen.*

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> November

**Morning:**

Reading: HEBREWS 9:11-15.

Meditation: pause with God this new morning. Prayerfully consider these words written here.

- Jesus's blood
- Eternal redemption

And then turn to prayer.

*Lord Jesus, You paid our ransom.  
You took all our sin to the cross,  
giving us life through You.  
We commit this day to You,  
the living God, who walked among us,  
who suffered, died and then rose to eternal glory.  
Help us live in Your light.  
In Your name, amen.*

### **Midday:**

We pray God's blessing on the staff teams of OPEN DOORS.

*Lord, bless those who work to remove the persecution of Your people in this world,  
amen.*

### **Evening:**

Read the verses again from HEBREWS 9:11-15.

Reflect and then pray to the LORD our God.

*Lord, we were separated from You by our own deeds.  
You have bridged that gap,  
re-built the path to be in Your presence.  
At the end of this day, we ask for cleansing.  
Wash our failing away,  
so tomorrow we can start afresh in Your power.  
In Your name, amen.*

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> November

### **Morning:**

Reading: HEBREWS 10:1-10.

Meditation: consider this passage this new morning...

"The sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all." (verse 10)

...and then respond in prayer to this God, our God.

*Lord Jesus, Thank You for the gift of salvation.  
Nothing we could do, or give, would ever be enough,  
so You took all the sins of this world onto Yourself.  
We give this day to You,  
For the message of Salvation, by You,  
to be spread through us.  
In Your name, amen.*

### **Midday:**

We pray God's blessing on all supporters of OPEN DOORS in our world.

*Lord, bless those who support through acts and prayer to remove the persecution of  
Your people in this world, amen.*

### **Evening:**

Read the set verses again from HEBREWS 10:1-10.  
reflect on what is said here and then pray to this God we believe in.

*Lord Jesus, we praise You.  
Your works are great and we are small,  
but please use us to bring Your light to this dark world.  
Although we have fallen short today,  
we ask You to cleanse us from our sins,  
becoming fresh tomorrow for Your works.  
In Your name, amen.*

Friday 7<sup>th</sup> November

### **Morning:**

Reading: HEBREWS 12:1-3.

Meditation: As we pause with God, we take the time to consider these verses.

“let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us”

And then pray in response to God.

*Father, we look to Your throne,  
in praise,  
with faith,  
for guidance.  
Lord Jesus, You endured the cross,  
then ascended back to heaven.*

*We look to Your throne,  
guide our path today.

that we can stand strong in our faith,  
and walk Your path.*

Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> November

**Morning:**

Reading: HEBREWS 13:15+16.

Meditation: as we pause with Jesus today, we take time to consider these verses.

- Continual offering

And then pray to Him.

*Father, we sacrifice this day to You.*

*Our words and deeds are Yours to guide.*

*We praise you with each word.*

*You are almighty, victorious and wonderful.*

*You are the Father of my heart.*

*In Jesus' name, amen.*

**Midday:**

Pray the words of the Lord's Prayer as your own prayer today.

*Our Father, who art in heaven,  
Hallowed be thy name.*



*Thy Kingdom come.  
Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread.  
And forgive us our debts,  
as we forgive our debtors.  
And lead us not into temptation,  
but deliver us from evil.  
For thine is the Kingdom,  
the power and the glory, forever.  
Amen.*

### **Evening:**

Read the verses again from HEBREWS 13:15+16.  
Reflect and pray in response to what you read.

Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> November

### **Morning:**

Reading: HEBREWS 13:20+21.

Meditation: we take time with God to consider these particular words on this Sunday morning.

- For ever and ever

And then we pray to Father God in response, humbly, honestly.

*Father in heaven, we thank You for the eternity that You give to us.  
Today we think of all those who are damaged, injured or lost due to war.  
Thank You that we will meet our sisters and brothers again, in heaven.  
In Jesus' name, amen.*

### **Midday:**

Pray the words of the Prayer for the Month as your own prayer

*Jesus Christ, the Supreme King,  
Guide us this day, week and month,  
To follow your teachings,  
To show Your love and our faith through our deeds.*

*Help us to hold strong in times of suffering,  
Recognizing those who would lead us astray.  
We worship You, our LORD,  
Amen.*

**Evening:**

Read these verses again from Hebrews 13:20+21.

Reflect and then pray to this God of ours as we step into a new week – together – with Him.

*Lord, on this remembrance Sunday we look to You.  
We do not understand why death and injury darken our lives,  
so we remember those who have will not grow old as we do.  
We ask for comfort for all those suffering, illness, injury and bereavement.  
In Your name, amen.*

Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November

**Morning:**

Reading: JAMES 5:7-11.

Meditation: as we pause with God, we take time to consider these particular words today...

“Be patient, then brothers and sister, until the Lord’s coming.”

...And then pray in response.

*Lord Jesus, fill us patience while we wait for Your return.  
Help us support our brothers and sisters with compassion  
and mercy as You have shown us.  
Thank You that we are counted as blessed.  
In Your name, amen.*

**Midday:**

We pray God’s blessing on believers in Ethiopia.

*Lord, bring provision and equality to all in Ethiopia, amen.*

**Evening:**

Read the verses again from JAMES 5:7-11.

Reflect and then pray to this God in response.

*Lord, we look ahead, eager for You to come again.  
Until then, help us be patient and stand firm,*

*being a vessel for Your message until that day.  
In Your name, amen.*

Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> November

**Morning:**

Reading: 1 PETER 1:3-9.

Meditation: as we pause with God we consider these words from Paul.

- Suffer grief to prove faith

And then respond in prayer with Him

*Father in heaven, we thank You for the living hope of Your resurrection.  
Today, again, we think of all those who's live has been touched by war.  
Thank You that we will meet our sisters and brothers again, in heaven.  
In Jesus' name, amen.*

**Midday:**

Take time to listen for God to speak with you – ask, seek, knock – hear!

*We are here Lord, we knock, we seek, we hear, amen.*

**Evening:**

Read the words again from 1 PETER 1:3-9.

Reflect and then pray in response to our God.

*Lord, on this Remembrance Day we turn to You.  
We do not understand why wars plague this world,  
but we will mourn for those who to not grow old.  
We ask for comfort for all those suffering, illness, injury and bereavement.  
In Your name, amen.*

Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> November

**Morning:**

Reading: 1 PETER 1:13-16.

Meditation: pause with God this new day. Consider these words written here.

*“with minds that are alert...set your hope on the grace ... revealed at his coming”*

Then turn to pray to God.

*Lord, awaken us.  
Keep our minds alert.*

*We set our hope on Your grace.  
We wait expectantly for Your coming again.  
With Your help, we turn away from our evil desires,  
to live with You in obedience.  
In Your name, amen.*

**Midday:**

We pray God's blessing on believers in Sudan.

*Bring freedom and peace to Your children there, amen.*

**Evening:**

Read the verses again from 1 PETER 1:13-16.  
reflect and then pray to the LORD our God.

*Father, at the end of this day we ask for peace.  
Forgive us when we took the wrong path today,  
said the wrong time and hurt ourselves or others.  
Restore and renew us to live better tomorrow,  
to praise You for the grace, love and hope we have in You.  
In Jesus' name, amen.*

Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> November

**Morning:**

Reading: 1 PETER 2:4-10.

Meditation: as we pause with God today, we consider this passage this morning.

- Precious, chosen, living stones

And then respond in prayer to this Jesus.

*Lord, You have called us into Your wonderful light.  
You have given us mercy and life.  
We have made us the living stones of Your church,  
built on the Your message as the cornerstone of hope.

Take time to reflect and pray to Father God.

Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> November

Meditation: as we pause with Jesus, we take time to consider these words.

- Be prepared
- Clear conscious towards God

And then pray to this God.

*Lord, we look to You for guidance,  
You are our example of suffering with grace.  
Help us Lord, we stand firm in our faith  
and defend You with grace, gentleness and respect.  
In Your name, amen.*

**Midday:**

Pray the words of the Lord's Prayer as your own prayer today.

Hallowed be thy name.  
Thy Kingdom come.  
Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread.

as we forgive our debtors.

For thine is the Kingdom,  
the power and the glory, forever.  
Amen.*

Read the verses again from 1 PETER 3:15-22.

Reflect and pray in response to what you read.

Help us to hold strong in times of suffering,  
Recognizing those who would lead us astray.  
We worship You, our LORD,  
Amen.*

Read these set words again from 1 PETER 4:12-19.

Reflect and then pray to this God of ours.

Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> November

... and then we take the time to respond in prayer with Him – asking, seeking, knocking.

*Lord, we are impatient, You are not.  
You keep Your promises, in Your time.

Years to us, are moments to You.  
You are everywhere and do amazing things.  
We praise You each moment today.  
For ever and ever, amen.*

... And then turn to pray to God.

We pray God's blessing on believers in Syria.

Read the words again from 1 JOHN 5:1-12.

Reflect and then pray in response to our God.

and left it behind.*

*Help us tomorrow to remember*

*that your commands are not burdensome.*

And then respond in prayer to this God, our God.

We look to You to hold our path straight,  
for our actions to be only those of goodness.  
In Jesus' name, amen.*

**Midday:**

We pray God's blessing on believers in Turkey.

*Bring protection, safety and freedom to practise their beliefs, amen.*

**Evening:**

Read the verses again from 3 JOHN.

Reflect on all that is said here and then pray to this God we believe in.

*Lord Jesus, friend and brother,  
You are the leader of truth and honour.  
We turn to You for the example  
of how to do what is good,  
and resist acts of evil.  
In Your name, amen.*

Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November

**Morning:**

Reading: JUDE verses 1+2.

Mediation: as we pause with God, we take the time to consider these words.

*"loved in God the Father and kept for Jesus Christ"*

And then pray in response to Him.

Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> November

Meditation: we take time to consider these words this Sunday morning.

*“keep you from stumbling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy”*

... And then we pray to this God in response.

Reflect and then pray to this God of ours.

we start the celebration of Your coming  
to this earth in human form, as Your son, Jesus.  
The word, before all ages,  
now, and forever,  
we talk to You and look to Your majesty.  
Help us each day to act as Your example shows,  
to stand tall and not to stumble.  
In Your name, amen.*
